## Coach Behavior and Attitude: 5 Points

It is not the intention to have completely passive coaches. It is acceptable to give positive advice to players **AFTER** a move or passage of play.

<b>Aggressive with his/her own players for mistakes on the field</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Humiliating players</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Coaching players by constantly calling the next move (over coaching)</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Aggression towards the opposing players or coaches</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Constantly arguing with Game Leader</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Total</b>	<b>/5</b>

## Players Behavior and Attitude: 5 Points

Children are naturally competitive and this should not be discouraged, but care should be taken to avoid this enthusiasm developing into aggressive behavior.

<b>Aggressive Behavior</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Arguing with Game Leader</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Obscenities - offensive language or behavior</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Taunting or being abusive towards opponents on field</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>
<b>Disrespectful behavior towards teammates and coaches</b>	<i>Deduct 1 point</i>

## Parents Behavior: 5 Points

While we understand the aspirations they have for their children, they have to accept that their contribution at competitions is restricted to **encouragement only**.
